Last week you would have read the sad news that Bill Green (WEG) died. [January 1 2009 - AGE - Wielded whirlwind pencil](#)

Bill Green was a long standing friend of Roy Morgan and those who worked with my father in the 1950s and early 1960s. The Herald's cartoonist's office was next to ours on the 3rd floor in Gravure House (26 Flinders Street, now Hotel Lindrum) which in the early 1960s had one of Melbourne's last lifts operated by the water's pressure (Water lift).

My father was a Melbourne City Councillor in 1971, Chairman of Melbourne Building and Town Planning and a "green"!

There are numerous WEG cartoons on our walls at 401 Collins St. WEG often sketched my father in his WEG's Day.
